The Vision Implementation Team (VIT) is a group of community members representing all organizations listed as a **lead partner** on **three or more** action items in the Vision Action Plan, plus one youth and one community at-large member. The at-large members are not affiliated with an agency or organization, and are selected through an application process demonstrating how their lived experience, professional background, or skill sets will contribute to moving the Vision Action Plan forward. At-large members serve a one-year term on the team, and the seats have not yet been filled for 2019. The 2019 VIT met for the first time in July and will meet at least quarterly through July 2020.

The goals of the VIT include working together to prioritize projects and update the proposed timeline of the Vision Action Plan, identify and dissolve barriers to progress, suggest and secure funding for projects, and communicate progress to the public. The VIT is currently working to develop a charter, which will be published on sistersvision.org.
